Lent, that season that begins with Ash Wednesday is upon us on March 6. We will, once again, offer midweek worship on Wednesdays at 11am and 7pm. Lent is a time to get serious about our faith and be intentional about growing that faith as we remember the price that Jesus paid to bring us these redeeming, life-giving messages of love and acceptance from God's own heart.

So, dear friends, it's time to Quit Church.

It's time to quit, to give up, to surrender, to let go of the actions and attitudes and approaches that have held you back – and held the church back – from experiencing all that God has for your life, and the life of the church. Do I have your attention? Good! Come each Wednesday during Lent and experience what this might mean for you and your walk with God! I have loosely based this on the book, *Quit Church* by Chris Sonksen. His theology definitely is NOT Lutheran, the principles are good! So, while I don't advise you to read the book, know that this is where the concepts derive. Your Congregation Council enjoyed a small retreat and worked together to formulate some goals for this year, under the theme for this year *This is Church*! Each Sunday, in the Prelude slide, you will see photos of what church is – which goes FAR beyond what happens when we gather on Sunday mornings! I hope you'll pay attention and contribute a few photos of your own.

The goals for this year are:

- 2. Get current on technology
- 3. Get streaming services up and running
- 4. Have a new Youth person in place before Sarah leaves in May.
- 5. Develop and utilize small groups in a more intentional way
- 6. Bring new people into our worship
- 7. Have a solid implementation plan for the 10 Year Committee report.

As it is March, I'm feeling the stress of the new Youth person most acutely! We will need to be on this now. It's not easy to find the right fit, so your prayers are coveted.
