Pray: Light a candle. Open your devotion with prayer.

God of Life, you astounded the women at the tomb with the surprising news of Jesus' resurrection. May their awe and joy be ours as we also go out to spread the gospel of life and salvation, in the name of Christ our Lord. Amen.



Read: Read the key verse from Sunday's reading.

The women were terrified and bowed their faces to the ground, but the men said to them, "Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here, but has risen." (Luke 24:5)



Reflect: Reflect on the scripture summary.

Mary, the women, and Peter were amazed and perplexed by the empty tomb. Clearly, Jesus' story is not finished. He is alive!



Connect: Connect in conversation with others in your household.

What was a high point of your day? What was a low point?

What do you still want to write into your life story? How does your faith shape your story?

Who will you celebrate Jesus' story with this week? What traditions mean the most to you?
