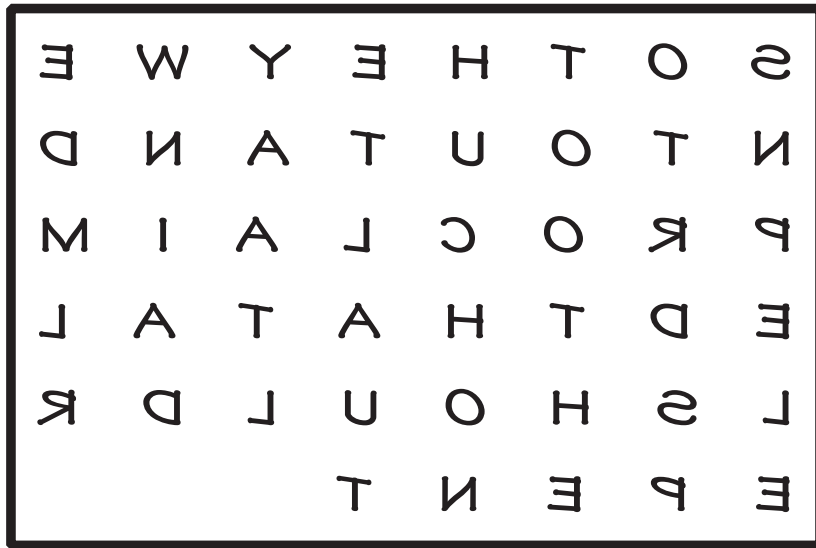
Jesus sent his disciples out on the road. Add lemons to the tree. Draw a lemonade stand in its shade. It's free lemonade for traveling disciples!
