
## Not So Joyful

Did you know that many congregations don't say or sing the word Alleluia during Lent? The word is considered too joyful for this solemn season.


What songs did you sing in worship today? What were some of the important words in each song?






Today is the **5<sup>th</sup> Sunday** in Lent. ٠


Fill the words of the memory verse into the blank crossword puzzle.
