Each week in worship, we hear readings from the Bible. Use the hints in the word ladder to make a new word by changing just one letter. Hints in **bold** are books of the Bible.



Palm Sunday to Good Friday



Then Jesus, crying with a loud voice, said, "Father, into your hands I commend my spirit." Having said this, he breathed his last. – Luke 23:46




As Jesus died, he quoted the words of a Psalm. Do the math to learn which verse it comes from.
